Jan Pholkosol is an intern at Chun & Chun Law. She worked at the Norwegian Refugee Council (NRC) as an Institutional Partnership Administrator, providing grant management support to NRC countries' operations while interning at the UN Refugee Agency (UNHCR), where she directly applied the UNHCR framework, international law, and US policies to assist asylum seekers in detention with their legal cases. She also interned at the Permanent Mission of Thailand to the UN, where she drafted a diplomatic telegram of UN meetings and gave Thai capital recommendations reflecting the national interest, and at the International Rescue Committee (IRC), helping refugees in New York achieve economic self-sufficiency.

Jan obtained a bachelor's degree in International Studies and Political Science with a minor in Law, Societies, and Justice focusing on global development, humanitarian issues, international law, and conflict resolution from the University of Washington in 2022. While pursuing her degree, she was a Research Assistant to the International Studies Department, conducting research on human rights violations, policy concerns, and migration across the EU while developing policy proposals. She also worked as a Project Coordinator for the COVID relief project in Bangkok as well as an English Teacher in the North of Thailand from 2020-2021.
